Thanks to those parishioners who have returned their stewardship commitment forms. We've received 202 forms from 464 families, 44% of our parish. The commitments total is \$485,182.02 which is 64% of our proposed budget.

We are getting closer to our goal and only need 220 more families to make a commitment of at least \$1, 200 for the next fiscal year to meet our budget needs.
